- 1. <u>Introduction</u>. The scheme of Sainik School was introduced in 1961 with the primary aim of preparing boys for entry into National Defence Academy and to bring Public School Education within the reach of the common man. There are 28 such schools all over the country. These schools are affiliated to CBSE and are run under the aegis of Ministry of Defence. A Board of Governors under the Chairmanship of the Defence Minister is the Chief Executive body of the Sainik Schools Society. Schools are managed by Sainik Schools Society. A Local Board of Administration (LBA), Chaired by the senior most Defence officer of the area, at school level manages the school affairs.
- 2. <u>Aim</u>. The scheme to establish Sainik Schools was introduced in 1961 with the primary aim of preparing boys academically, physically and "mentally" for entry into the National Defence Academy. The other objectives of the scheme are:-
 - (a) To remove regional imbalance in the officer cadre of the defence services.
 - (b) To develop qualities of body, mind, heart and character which will enable the young boys of today to become good and useful citizens of tomorrow.
 - (c) To bring public school education within the reach of the common man.
- 3. <u>Vision</u>. Sainik School Ambikapur is committed to provide best possible experience, environment and education to its Cadets. It intends to groom Cadets in such a way that they are ready to take challenges of life and fit to join National Defence Academy.
- 4. <u>Location</u>. Sainik School Ambikapur is a fully residential English medium school up to class XII. It started functioning with effect from 01 Sep 2008 from its present location in Surguja district of Chhattisgarh. At present more than 550 boys are there on its strength. Sainik school Ambikapur is Located at Surguja district in northern part of Chhattisgarh. It borders UP, Jharkhand, Orissa and MP States. Nearest major Rail Head is Anuppur (220 Km).

- Affiliation. Sainik School Ambikapur is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Affiliation Number of this school is 3380001. This school follows CBSE curriculum for all the classes. At present, it offers Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics with Computer Science or Biology for Classes XI and XII. There is no option to take "Arts" subjects in this school. The medium of instruction at the School is English.
- 6. Management and Faculty. Colonel Jitendra Dogra, on deputation from Indian Army, is the Principal of the school. Lieutenant Colonel Arvind Nautival, on deputation from Indian Army is the Vice Principal and Commander Sandeep Murarka, on deputation from Indian Navy is the Administrative Officer of the school. There are also three NCC and two Physical Training Instructors from Indian Army. The School has highly qualified teaching faculty and highly experienced administrative staff on its roll.



7. National Cadets' Corps (NCC). NCC aims to develop comradeship. character, discipline,

leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, and ideals of selfless service amongst the youth of the country. NCC Training is compulsory for all Cadets in Sainik Schools irrespective of their age. The Sainik



Schools are authorized of an Independent NCC (JD) Company. Boys of the school participate in number of NCC camps and learn drill as a part of curriculum. The Cadets earn NCC 'A'/'B' certificates by the time they pass out of the school, which are of immense advantage to them.

8. Co-Curricular Activities, Games & Sports.

Enrichment of social and cultural habits ultimately shapes a balanced personality individual when switching over from adolescence to adulthood.




Physical fitness and overall development of the boys is one of the main aims of the school. Regular PT, Games and Sports are held

throughout the stay of the Cadets in the school. Facilities for Games

and Sports such as Hockey, Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Badminton, Athletics, Handball, Archery etc are available in the School. There are number of Hobby Clubs in the school. The school has Horse Riding Club.



Construction of Outdoor Stadium is in progress. Indoor Stadium and Swimming Pool is going to come up in coming years. Visits to places of interest and specially related to defence establishments





CBSE (Science Stream) topper for Class XII and one of our Cadets had also secured All India Rank-I in UPSC examination for NDA. Many of our







Cadets are now perusing higher studies in Medical/Engineering/Delhi University/Banaras Hindu University for graduation. Special classes are conducted for UPSC preparation and specialist give guidance for Service Selection Board Exams.

10. **UPSC & NDA**. Sainik School Ambikapur, groom Cadets for life without sacrificing their

areas of specialization or competence. Hence, here it is our endeavour to give balanced importance to formal education, extra co-curricular activities and value based education so that their head and heart develops simultaneously. This wholesome personality development approach coupled with NCC training will make our



Cadets confident and responsible citizens with positive attitude of this country and ultimately help



them in accomplishing their prime goal of joining NDA and NAVAC (INA). One of our Cadet has secured first rank in the merit list published by Union Public Service Commission for selection into National Defence Academy and Naval Academy. In a short span of three years, the school has been able to send 28 Cadets to National Defence Academy/Officers Training

Academy/Armed Force Medical College. Two Cadets have already graduated from National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla, Pune and joined Indian Military Academy and Indian Naval Academy.

11. <u>Library</u>. The School has a well stocked library with 7000+ books covering various subjects. It has great collection of fictions for children. Library has internet connected Kiosks, Thirty subscribed magazines, Exclusive NDA related books, CDs and number of E- books and above it an experienced Librarian, who guides boys to inculcate habit of reading.



- 12. <u>House System</u>. The school has recently constructed spacious new Cadets hostels with the facilities of separate TV room, study room and Gym. To foster Espirit-de-Corps, fraternity, community living and team work the hostels are divided into various Houses. The Housemasters assisted by the Ward Boys look after the boys and supervise their general health and personal hygiene. The house system provides ample opportunities to inculcate and hone leadership qualities in the Cadets. Junior Cadets stay in separate houses.
- 13. <u>Messing</u>. The School has state of art Cadet Mess. Mess is run by the school. It can accommodate around 1000 Cadets at a time. There is a Mess Committee consisting of Administrative Officer as Chairman and representative of the staff and Cadets as members. It meets frequently to suggest the menu and discuss other catering matters. Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian meals are served in the mess. Teachers and other authorized staff dine in the Mess along with boys.



14. <u>Medical Facilities</u>. The School has a MI Room looked after by a qualified Nursing Assistant and a Medical Attendant. A qualified doctor has been engaged by the school administration who visits school regularly to check up the boys and monitor their general health/growth. Periodical medical camps are held in the school. Two Ambulances are available to take Cadets to the nearby hospitals for treatment if the need arise. Parents are informed immediately in case of any serious injury/ illness. There is a Sick Bay which can accommodate 20 Cadets.

- 15. <u>Travelling During Vacations</u>. Cadets are not allowed to leave the school without any escort. One of the parents/guardians or an escort duly authorized in writing by the parents/guardians always accompany them on their way back to home. The parents /guardians / authorized escorts of these Cadets are required to collect them from the school on the day of the dispersal at the appointed hours without fail.
- 16. <u>Cadets' Leave and Visits by Parents</u>. Leave is normally not granted to Cadets during the session, in very exceptional circumstances, leave may be granted at the discretion of the Principal. Parents/ authorized guardians only can visit the school on the nominated day of the month between 1000 hrs and 1600 hrs after obtaining due permission. They are not permitted to take out boys without written permission of Principal. All hostels, Cadet Mess are out of bound for the Visitors. Parents/Guardians can meet their wards in the designated place. Parents are required to give name and details of local guardian along with a photo for the records of the school. Cadets are not permitted to go out with the unauthorized person. Any other visit to the school will be on a working day with prior appointment between 1000 hrs to 1300 hrs only.
- 17. <u>Signing of Indemnity Bond</u>. The parents/guardians of the Cadets are required to execute a bond to the effect that the school authorities will not be liable for any damage on account of injuries, fatal or otherwise, which may be sustained by a Cadet during his stay in the school while taking part in PT, games, sports or any other training activity inside or outside the school including educational Tours, Camps, Trekking etc.
- 18. <u>Correspondence</u>. Parents can communicate with the school quoting the Cadet Number, Name, Class and House of the boy together with a self addressed stamped envelope to facilitate prompt disposal. Parents should encourage letter writing. Parents are advised to browse our school web site <u>www.sainikschoolambikapur.org</u> in to know more about the school activities.
- 19. <u>Withdrawals</u>. All boys are admitted to the school on the understanding that they will remain in the school for the entire course. In case any of the parents wants to withdraw his son on any account, including revision of fees/ scholarship he must give the notice of withdrawal in writing to the Principal at least two months before the commencement of the following term. Failure to give this notice will entail forfeiture of caution money. <u>Parents of boys who are in receipt of scholarships can withdraw them only after repayment of the total amount of scholarship enjoyed by the boys.</u> However, the Principal can, in the interest of the school, remove any Cadet from the school as per the school rules.
- 20. <u>School Fee</u>. School fees is to be paid in advance and is charged in full for the entire academic year commencing from 01st April to 31st March. The school fees are to be paid in lump sum at the time of admission/in the beginning of the year. The school fees for this session is as under:-

Note. In case of any increase of school fees and other charges including diet charges by the Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence/ Principal Sainik School Ambikapur, parents will be required to pay the increased amount on intimation by due date.

21. <u>Payment of fees</u>. The school fee is required to be paid in <u>full</u> at the time of admission. For subsequent years, fee will be paid in advance on installments as under:-

(a)	Full fee in lump sum	On or before re-opening of the School after summer Vacation.
(b)	Half Yearly fee plus Rs 100/- along with each payment in two installments.	1 st installment on 01 June. 2 nd installment on 01 November.
(c)	Quarterly Fee plus Rs 100/- along with each payment	1 st installment on 01 June. 2 nd installment on 01 September. 3 rd installment on 01 December. 4 th installment on 01 March.

All payments are to be made through crossed Demand Draft only. The Demand Draft should be drawn in favour of "**Principal, Sainik School Ambikapur**" payable at any Nationalized Bank at Ambikapur {(**Preferred**: - State Bank of India, Main Branch, Ambikapur (**Code 00310**)}. **Cash will not be accepted**. Payment of dues to any staff members of the school for remittance to school will be entirely at the risk and responsibility of the individual making the payment.

22. <u>Scholarship</u>. Scholarships are granted by the concerned Government of Chhattisgarh/Bihar/Uttarakhand to those boys selected for admission to Sainik School Ambikapur and who are domicile of these states. Parents have to produce proof of their domicile and total income countersigned by the authorized District authorities to which they belong for grant of scholarship by their respective State Govts.

<u>Scholarship scheme</u>. Limited number of Ministry of Defence Scholarships is available to the children of Defence Personnel (Serving/Ex-service Personnel) on merit cum-means basis. The Ministry of Defence may determine the number of scholarships for each Sainik School at its own discretion. The amounts of these scholarships to the wards of Defence Personnel and Ex-servicemen are as under:-

Scholarships will be granted as per Sainik Schools Society rules. Full fee will be collected from such parents for the first year, which shall be adjusted, on release of the scholarships. The lost of scholarship on account of poor academic performance can be revived in subsequent years by securing laid down percentage. The parents/ guardians of scholarship holder Cadets are required to submit their income certificate to the school latest by first week of the May every year, failing which scholarship in respect of the concerned Cadet cannot be claimed and full fee will have to be paid by the parents/guardians. Parents / guardians of the Cadets who are in receipt of scholarships will have to execute bonds to the

effect that their sons/wards will appear in UPSC examination of NDA and if selected, will join NDA. In case such Cadets do not undertake all the chances for admission to NDA or do not join NDA, if selected, the full amount of scholarship availed will be recovered by the school on behalf of the State/Centre Government concerned. Non-payment of scholarship in such case will be considered as an offence and necessary action will be taken at individual's cost. Scholarship can be retained or taken away by the school from a Cadet as per the rules and regulations in vogue or as prescribed by Sainik School Society from time to time.

- 23. **Definition of Income (For Scholarship Holders)**. Definition of Income is as follows:-
 - (a) Income of the salaried class shall be determined based on the salary certificate/Form-16 issued by the employer.
 - (b) Other than salaried class, Income certificate issued by the competent authority as per respective state govt.
- 24. <u>Income of Serving Personnel/Ex-Servicemen</u>. As per Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence Rules in vogue, Scholarship is provided based on the Rank of Serving personnel and Rank of Ex-Serviceman at the time of retirement.
- 25. <u>Infrastructure</u>. Govt of Chhattisgarh has allotted 84 acres of land to the school for its permanent infrastructure at village Mendran Kalan of Surguja district. The construction work is almost completed.
- 26. <u>Selection & Reservation</u>. Admission is made in the Class VI and Class IX only through an All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE) which is held on the first Sunday of January every year. The age of a boy should be 10 -12 years for Class VI and 13 15 years for Class IX as on 31 March of the year in which admission is sought. Applications of boys will not be registered if found overage / underage or on any other grounds and will be rejected by the school. The decision of the school in this regard will be final. There is no age relaxation of age limits to any category. The following reservations of seats are available to the Cadets on the basis of Caste, State and Service:
 - (a) 15% of the total seats for Scheduled Caste and 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribes
 - (b) Out of the remaining 67% of the seats (75% General category and 25% Defence Personnel including ex-servicemen) will be reserved for the boys of Chhattisgarh.
 - (c) 33% left over of seats (75% General category and 25% Defence Personnel including ex-servicemen) will be thrown open to boys from other States and Union Territories in the ratio of their male population. Any unutilized seats in this category will be merged with home state seats.
- 27. <u>All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE)</u>. - 28. **Qualifying Standards**. On the basis of performance in written examination a merit list of boys qualifying in the examination will be prepared and short-listed candidates will be called for Medical Examination by the Medical Board appointed by the competent authority. The standards of health and medical fitness for admission to a Sainik School would be the same as laid down for the National Defence Academy. A nominal fee per candidate will be charged for Medical Examination.
- 29. In case boys who are qualified but low in merit in schools on their domicile and whose parents are willing to admit their wards in other Sainik Schools, will be required to give an undertaking that "they are willing to admit their sons/wards as full paying (fees) Cadets in other Sainik Schools of their choice and under any circumstances will not seek inter-school transfer till the end of completion of studies of their wards in the Sainik Schools once they are selected/admitted". They will be allowed to identify/indicate any three Sainik Schools of their choice/preference as first, second and third in order of their choice.
- **30.** <u>Medical Review</u>. The decision of the Medical Board will be final except where a representation has been made to the Principal within 15 days of the conduct of medical examination. The Principal will examine the appeal himself and decide with reference to the evidence produced before him if the case calls for a Review Medical on merit. A case in which competent medical opinion is produced to counter the findings of previous Medical Board, will normally merit a review. The Principal may arrange a Review Medical Board for re-examination of the candidate. If the Review Medical Board finds him fit for admission, the Principal will admit him to the School if his rejection was only on account of lack of medical fitness. The School will charge a fee of Rs. 100/- (Rs. 50/- for SC & ST category) for holding the Review Medical Board. There is no provision for holding second Review Medical Board. Additional expenditure, if any, will be borne by the School. However, the candidate will be required to appear before the Review Medical Board at the place designated by school at his own expenses. In case the Review Medical Board finds him fit for admission, the fee charged from the parent will be refunded.
- 31. <u>Admit Cards</u>. Parents will download the Admit Card of their ward on their respective registered User ID and Password. Candidates will not be allowed to appear in written in examination without Admit Card.
- 32. Result. A final category wise merit list of boys selected for admission will be prepared based on performance in the written subject to medical fitness strictly in the order of merit applicable to each category viz. Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, General and Defence and the boys will be called upon to join the school on specific dates. New Admissions in Sainik School Ambikapur for Classes VI/IX will most likely be done in the first week of April. Call-up letters/joining instruction would be sent to the parents of the selected candidates. If any candidate does not turn up for admission on the stipulated date, the vacancy will be offered to the next in the waiting list of appropriate category.
- 33. <u>Admission Procedure</u>. The boys called for admission should report on the date alongwith father/guardian. The person who will be executing the admission documents in respect of a boy should invariably be present in the School alongwith the boy. Admission will be refused if the correct mandatory documents/certificates are not being produced on the day of admission.

<u>Important Note.</u> All parents/guardians may please note that terms and conditions for Entrance Examination as given in the prospectus are liable to change with or without prior notice by the School administration depending upon administrative contingencies or exigencies arising at any time and as per directives received from the Board of Governors, Sainik School Society. Information contained in this booklet is informative in nature and cannot be quoted as rule or guidance. Principal, Sainik School Ambikapur reserves the right to amend/correct data. Parents are requested to not to give any item more than the permitted items to the boys. Cadets are not permitted to keep cash /valuable with them. Money Orders addressed to the Cadets will be received by the School and credited to Pocket Money Account of the concerned Cadet. Cadets are also not permitted to possess Mobile Phone, Radio, Tape Recorder, Walkman, Transistors, Alarm Clock, Personal watch etc. during their stay in the School. These, if found will be confiscated by the School.
