1. Picture Composition (Minimum 100 words)

- Imagine what might happen next in the scene.

2. Story Writing (120–150 words)

Theme: A Magical Adventure

Prompt:

Write a story about a boy or girl who finds a mysterious key in their school bag. Where does the key take them? What do they discover? Who helps or challenges them along the way?

Instructions:

- Begin with “One day, as I opened my school bag, I found a shiny, golden key...”
- Include at least two characters (main and helper/friend or villain).
- Describe the setting (Where are they? What does the place look like?).
- End with how the adventure finishes and what they learned.

3. Personal Essay (100–120 words)

Topic: My Best Holiday Ever

Instructions:

Write a short essay describing:

- Where you went.
- Who you went with.
- What activities you enjoyed.
- Your most favorite moment.
- How you felt at the end.

Focus on writing in the past tense and using descriptive words (adjectives) to make it interesting.

#### 4. Letter Writing (Informal, 100-120 words)

Topic: Write a letter to your cousin telling them about your summer holiday plans.

Instructions:

- Start with “Dear [Name],”
- Describe where you are going, how you will travel, who is coming with you.
- Share what you are most excited about.
- Ask your cousin about their holiday plans.
- End with a warm closing: “Yours lovingly” or “With love.”

#### 5. Dialogue Writing (10–12 lines)

Topic: Conversation between two friends planning a picnic.

Instructions:

- Give names to the two friends.
- Include lines where they discuss:
  - Where to go.
  - What food to bring.
  - What games or activities they will do.
  - What time they will meet.

- Use proper dialogue format with names and colons, e.g.

Rahul: Where should we go for the picnic?

Meena: Let's go to the lakeside park!
